Our recent launchings:

The new Whakatane Coastguard Rescue Vessel was launched in October. This 10m Naiad is powered by a pair of 300hp Yamaha 4 strokes and has a top speed of over 45 knots. The state of the art electronics are from Raymarine.

The Kingfishercat 900 and 1000 models were both launched a week prior to the Auckland boat show. Sea trialling involved a 130

nm charge up the coast through very unpleasant seas to arrive in Auckland on time. We were delighted with how they handled the conditions and acknowledge that few other boats of this size would have been anywhere near as comfortable.

Kingfisher 430s. We struggled to keep up with demand during the winter special period but backlog is now minimal.
