Displacement powercats the future?

We have this new Kingfisher displacement cat under design at the moment. These crafts offer amazing economy as they are so easily pushed by low horsepower engines. This 12m overall design is expected to achieve 24 knots with a pair of 125hp outboards or diesel inboards, and with minimal wake. Slow cruising at 10 knots would use approximately 7 litres petrol per hour per engine on the outboard model, and at 20 knots, 9 litres per hour – subject to loading and sea conditions.



The vessel pictured has the optional forward raking screen.

Houseboat Shares for sale

This is a 12m alloy pontoon houseboat built by Alloy Cats Ltd in 2005. She is currently set up for river cruising but with minor alterations will be converted to a very comfortable houseboat for extended holidays on sheltered waters – whether river, lake or harbour of owners' choice. She's powered by twin Suzuki 70hp 4 stroke outboards and cruises very economically at around 7/8 knots. The vessel has toilet with holding tank, 500 litres water, a large cockpit BBQ, shower, capstan and very comfortable interior décor.



We have only two 25% shares available in this vessel for \$72,000 each. For this price, an approved purchaser would get a minimum of 13 weeks use of the houseboat per year. The self contained vessel comes with a Kingfisher 475 trailerboat which can be towed behind and used for water sports, beach landings, transportation and fishing.
